

VULNERABILITY REPORT FOR REGULARIZATION OF MIGRANT PERSONS

WHO ISSUES IT?

- City council social services or accredited social organizations

WHO CAN REQUEST IT?

- Individuals registered in the municipality who wish to apply for the regularization process provided by the Spanish Government

WHO IS EXEMPT FROM IT?

- 1- Individuals who have worked legally in Spain or who have a job offer for a minimum of 90 days over a period of one year
- 2- Individuals who are in Spain with their family unit and live together (registered at the same address), provided that the family unit includes minor children, adult children with disabilities, or ascendants (parents or parents-in-law)
- 3- Individuals who applied for International Protection before January 1, 2026

HOW TO APPLY

- Starting Monday, April 27th. In person at the Citizen Service Office from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM, Monday to Friday, or online through the city council website.
- Required documents:
 - 1- Application form provided by the city council (available on this website)
 - 2- Passport

INFORMATION AND SUPPORT TO COMPLETE THE REQUEST FORM

- The Migration Department will hold a session to assist with completing the request form for the vulnerability report on Monday, April 27th, from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM at the SAFI (Local Police Building - c. Amadeu Paltor, 28).

This report will only be valid for the purposes of the regularization provided for in Royal Decree 316/2026
